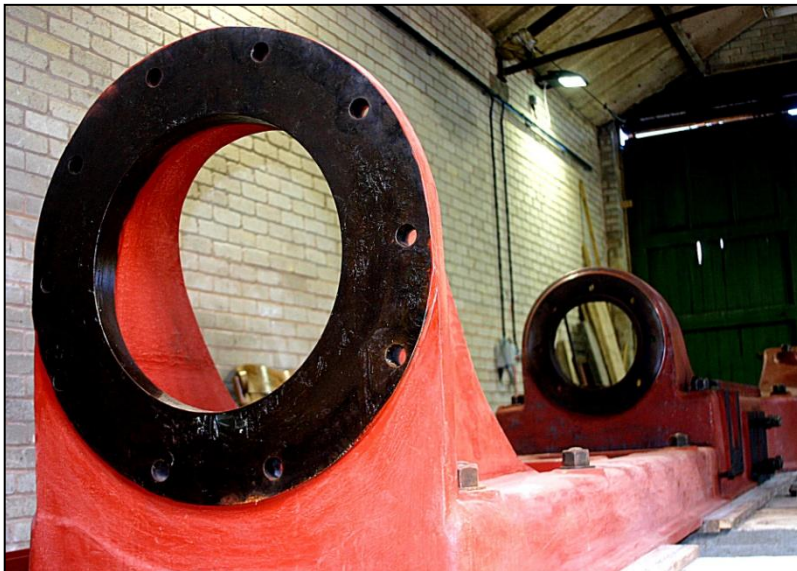

The shop and cafeteria will be open as usual, free car park on site. Guided tours of the whole site are proving to be popular, ask at reception or the shop, there is no charge but a modest donation is always welcome.



The Bradley engine will again be open to view with work proceeding during the steaming. More parts are coming under close scrutiny as we look ahead; one part that must be replaced is a broken HP piston ring.

Fred F's recovery continues, we have been very pleased to see him at the mill again looking as well as he always did. Prudence dictates that he doesn't take on too much

at present and so the stand-in team will be running the engine.
